Event Details (Notice of Race)
16th & 17th November 2013



The regatta is being organized and hosted by Deviot Sailing Club and will be held on the Tamar River in the vicinity of Deviot Sailing Club, Tasmania.

1 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

1a Welcome and Briefing in front of clubhouse at 11 am – Saturday

1b Sailing - Saturday

1st race commencing – not before 11:30 am Saturday (ie Warning Signal not before 11:25 am)

Lunch approx. 12:30 pm till 1:30 pm

2nd Race commencing not before 1:30 pm and subsequent races sailed back to back with last start not after 5pm Saturday. Depending upon conditions there may be a long distance race of approx 2 hours first race after lunch. There may also be shorter races no longer than 1 hour sailed back to back after the long distance race.

1c Food and entertainment – Saturday evening commencing not before 6:30 pm, but with the bar open and snacks available immediately after sailing

The evening meal will be a two course barbecue at a cost of \$18 for adults and children over 12, and \$12 for children up to twelve.

Entertainment – a family friendly film will be shown during the evening. There is also a pool table and sound system. Other (safe) entertainment is to be encouraged, with prizes for the most 'entertaining'.

1d Sailing – Sunday

1st race commencing – not before 10am Sunday

Last race commencing not after 2:30 pm on Sunday

1e Trophy presentations – approximately 1 hour after last finisher

2 SAILING FORMAT

2a Event Style - as advertised, the theme of the event is 'Fun and Nostalgia'. Whilst there will be prizes awarded for yardstick results, the main aim is to have fun! Protests are to be discouraged, but this does not mean abandoning the rules. They remain in place, for legal and safety reasons, for everyone's protection— namely ISAF 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the specific regulations of the Yachting Australia (YA).

2b Sailing events – conditions permitting, there will be a long distance race of approx 2 hours on Saturday afternoon. There will be a mixture of other course events in the vicinity of the club waters, including a variety of course shapes, and potentially a speed trial event, and a 'freestyle' event. The freestyle event will be judged on the basis of skill and entertainment value. If there is insufficient wind to sail properly, some events may be deemed 'open' to alternative propulsion, eg. rocking, skulling, pumping, and even paddling – so bring paddles, but no outboards!

- 2c Starting and finishing will be as determined by the regatta committee on the day, either from the clubhouse control box or from a committee boat on the sailing course.

3 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded on yardstick to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings. Division 1 is sponsored by Tamar Marine. Division 2 is sponsored by Exeter Hardware, plus a host of fun awards, to be determined by the regatta committee. The divisions will be divided by yardstick with the final split between divisions will be determined by the numbers of boats. The event yardsticks will be based on current VYC tables. The event yardstick will be published at the welcome and briefing.

4 ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to any dinghy or catamaran, that carries one or more trapeze. Yardsticks for modified boats will be determined by the regatta committee. At least one member of each sailing crew must be a current member of a recognized sailing club and hold a YA Silver Card. Third party public liability insurance of at least \$5 million whilst recommended is optional.

5 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The Deviot Sailing Club and all parties involved in the events organization accept no liability for any loss, damage, death or injury which may occur to property or persons, both ashore and afloat, as a consequence of participation in this event. The establishment of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of a competitor being solely and entirely responsible for the management of a yacht that he/she is sailing.

6 LUNCHES

Lunches including salad rolls and pastries will be available during the regatta at the clubhouse from 11 am each day. To assist catering, pre-ordering your lunch each day will be appreciated.

7 CAMPING

Free camping is available in the clubhouse grounds, and there is limited space within the clubhouse as well. Prior arrangements must be made to leave the clubhouse open on Friday and Saturday nights, for use of toilets and showers, and for preparing breakfast (breakfast food not provided).

8 ENTRIES

The event entry fee is \$35 per boat.

Entries will be accepted up to 11 am on Saturday, 16th November, on the form attached. Late entries will be accepted during the event. The regatta committee may at it's discretion apply a late entry fee.
